## **RE: Indiana 20-02 Supplemental Order & Continuation of All Pepper Construction Project Operations in Indiana**

On Monday, March 23, 2020, Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb issued a supplement to Executive Order 20-02. The supplemental order mandates that certain businesses cease activities within the state.

**Section 11** of the Supplemental Executive Order specifically characterizes construction as “Essential Infrastructure,” and therefore exempt from the business closure order. Additionally, **Sections 14 (j) and (p)** of the Supplemental Order specify that building and construction trades, along with all suppliers supporting those trades, are “Essential Businesses and Operations,” also exempt from mandatory closure restriction. In compliance with the Order, Pepper Construction projects in Indiana will remain open for business on March 24, 2020 and for the foreseeable future. Pepper will continue to conduct construction operations in accordance with [current CDC guidelines](#), putting first the health and well-being of our workforce.
